Selection

The number of awards given in any specific year is at the discretion of the WGA Board. Directors will review nominations, vote on entries, and determine the number of honorees to be recognized.

Recognition

The recipient(s) of the WGA Vendor of the Year Award will be notified in June/July 2023. A press release and a surprise media event will be scheduled in advance to announce the award. A sign will be provided to display in the store or office.

Final honorees will be featured in the Expo Issue of the *Wisconsin Grocer* magazine, with special e-alerts, in the President's Letter e-newsletter, and on Wisconsin Grocers.com.

Honorees will receive awards at the Chairman's Banquet during the Grocers Innovation Expo, October 18, 2023 at the Hilton Paper Valley Hotel & Fox Valley Convention Center, Appleton, Wisconsin.
