Qualified candidates should spend at least 40% of their time at work in the front-end, bagging customers' groceries to compete in a Best Bagger competition. A bagger's primary duties must be classified as front-end staff and must have a non-managerial title, role, and set of responsibilities in order to be eligible to compete. A Best Bagger competition has served its purpose when the baggers have learned better bagging techniques, sportsmanship, and customers service skills.

Bag-Off Rules

Bag-Off Rules are the same in year's past. Judging criteria includes: speed, weight distribution, proper bag building technique and style, attitude and appearance.
